

Pack for a Purpose

Pack for a Purpose is a splendid small initiative to match travellers' philanthropy with local needs in the countries where they travel. Founded by Rebecca Rothney, the organisation has won several awards for the elegant simplicity of matching local needs and travellers' generosity.

Tiger Mountain was the first organisation in Nepal to join Pack for a Purpose. We support local education initiatives in the two main schools in our community as part of our wider Community Support Partnership Programme.

The schools we support with Pack for a Purpose

Sri Amar Jyoti Gaun Pharka School is a local government school, situated in the same village at Tiger Mountain Pokhara Lodge, that has a primary and secondary section serving 500 students from ages 3 through 18 years old. The school has a dynamic management committee and teaching staff but the school lacks a budget for even the most basic educational support resources.

Sri Shiva Shakti Primary School, which serves 135 students, is also close by Tiger Mountain Pokhara Lodge and feeds into Amar Jyoti Secondary School. As with Amar Jyoti, lack of budget means scarce resources have to be used for basic salaries of teachers, etc. leaving nothing for extended facilities. Tiger Mountain subsidises the cost of one teacher here and seeks support for more facilities for this deserving school.
